- 3. Be able to use a singing voice with a head tone as modeled by the teacher.
- 4. Be able to perform simple songs from memory in a concert situation.

#### Research-based Instructional Strategies

The teacher will model appropriate performance techniques for the class. This includes proper breathing techniques, ability to use singing voice with a head tone, and perform simple music from memory.

- 2. Be able to use quarter notes/rests and eighth-note pairs through clapping, singing, speaking and/or playing rhythm instruments.
- 3. Be able to physically employ melodic notation.
- 4. Be able to match pitch on middle C through G above middle C.

#### Depth of Knowledge

90% of students will reach the objective through thorough assessment.

#### Learning Activity

Students will:

- 1. work as a team to hold hands and create a circle without pushing or pulling other students.
- 2. move clockwise and counter clockwise while being in the hand holding circle.
- 3. sit, stand and move in a nonlocomotor assigned seat activity appropriately.
- 4. sit, stand and move in a locomotor activity appropriately.

#### Research-based Instructional Strategies

The teacher will demonstrate the proper way to use the space around her. She will then work with students on a large group, small group and individualized basis to assure that each student has a strong and working spatial awareness.
