Through the use of structured cultural, spiritual and seasonal circle games, students will demonstrate spatial awareness and respect. Through the use of unstructured movement activities, students will demonstrate self-awareness and creativity

90% of students will successfully reach the objective through thorough assessment.

Learning Activity

Through participation in various vocal, kinesthetic, tactile and audible activities, students will display an understanding of the differences between high and low. They will also demonstrate pitches using their voices and other pitched instruments to echo the teacher.

Research-based Instructional Strategies

Through various individualized, large and small group instructional activities, the teacher will introduce and demonstrate the differences in high and low pitches.
